THE SPECIAL SESSION OF COMMISSIONERS' COURT OF TRINITY COUNTY WAS HELD MONDAY, MARCH 21, 2011 AT 9:00AM IN THE COMMISSIONERS' COURTROOM, TRINITY COUNTY COURTHOUSE AUXILIARY COURTHOUSE, 218 WEST FIRST STREET, GROVETON, TEXAS, WITH THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS PRESENT:

1. JUDGE PAGE CALLED THE MEETING TO ORDER AT 9:00AM, WELCOMED EVERYONE TO THE MEETING AND NOTED THAT THE AGENDA WAS PROPERLY FILED AND POSTED. AGENDA WAS FILED 3-18-11 AT 8:20AM. ALL COMMISSIONERS WERE PRESENT. OTHER OFFICIALS PRESENT INCLUDED COUNTY ATTORNEY JOE WARNER BELL, COUNTY AUDITOR SHEILA JOHNSON AND COUNTY CLERK DIANE MCCRORY.
2. JENNIFER CULPEPPER, STARS AND STRIPES UNITED PATRIOTS, EXPLAINED THE DONATION OF AMERICAN, TEXAS AND POW FLAGS TO BE DISPLAYED AT THE COUNTY ROCK BUILDING AS WELL AS THE OFFICE BUILDING OF JUSTICES OF THE PEACE #2 AND #3. ON A MOTION FROM COMMISSIONER WORSHAM AND SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER CHAMBERLIN THE DONATION OF FLAGS WAS ACCEPTED. MOTION CARRIED.
3. JENNIFER CULPEPPER, STARS AND STRIPES UNITED PATRIOTS DISCUSSED DONATION AND INSTALLATION OF THREE FLAGPOLES. ON A MOTION FROM COMMISSIONER WEBB AND SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER BROWN THE DONATION OF FLAGPOLES AND INSTALLATION WAS ACCEPTED. MOTION CARRIED.
4. PROCLAMATION DECLARING THE MONTH OF MAY AS NATIONAL MILITARY APPRECIATION MONTH IN TRINITY COUNTY WAS APPROVED BY A MOTION FROM COMMISSIONER WORSHAM AND SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER BROWN. MOTION CARRIED.
5. ASSISTANT DISTRICT ATTORNEY BENNIE SCHIRO AND DISTRICT ATTORNEY INVESTIGATOR TRAVIS HAYGOOD ADDRESSED COMMISSIONERS REGARDING A \$42,000 GRANT FOR VICTIMS AGAINST CRIME COORDINATOR THROUGH OFFICE OF ATTORNEY GENERAL. ON A MOTION FROM COMMISSIONER WEBB AND SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER BROWN, THE GRANT WAS APPROVED AND THE RESOLUTION ACCEPTED BY COMMISSIONER COURT. MOTION CARRIED.
6. DROUGHT CONDITIONS WERE DISCUSSED BY COMMISSIONERS.
7. ON A MOTION FROM COMMISSIONER WORSHAM, SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER BROWN, DROUGHT CONDITIONS WERE FOUND PRESENT THAT WOULD BE EXACERBATED BY OUTDOOR BURNING. MOTION CARRIED.
8. AN ORDER PROHIBITING OUTDOOR BURNING WAS APPROVED BY A MOTION FROM COMMISSIONER BROWN AND SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER WORSHAM. MOTION CARRIED.
9. AT 10:00AM A PUBLIC HEARING WAS OPENED TO DISCUSS THE JURY OF VIEW PANEL HEARING AS REQUIRED FOR THE COUNTY ROAD MAP PROJECT. ALL 10 SELECTIONS MADE BY COMMISSIONERS AND COUNTY JUDGE WERE PRESENT. CHOSEN BY LOT TO SERVE ON THE JURY OF VIEW PANEL WERE TERRY OATES, MAX DUE, WILLIAM DOYLE, JOE DON KENNEDY AND J.E. ANDERSON. DURING THE PUBLIC HEARING THE JURY PANEL DETERMINED THAT BALL PARK ROAD IN THE NIGTON AREA AND WOMACK LANE AND JENNINGS DRIVE IN THE WESTVILLE AREA TO BE COUNTY ROADS, CASTING A MAJORITY VOTE ON THEIR DECISIONS. WITH NO OTHER MATTERS TO BE RESOLVED BY THE JURY OF VIEW, THEY WERE RELEASED FROM SERVICE AND THE PUBLIC HEARING WAS CLOSED AT 10:55AM.
10. WITH NO FURTHER BUSINESS TO BE PRESENTED TO COMMISSIONERS COURT, ON A MOTION FROM COMMISSIONER WEBB SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER BROWN, COURT WAS ADJOURNED AT 11:05AM. MOTION CARRIED.
