DECLARATION OF DISASTER EXTENSION OF ORIGINAL ORDER IN THE STATE OF TEXAS, COUNTY OF TRINITY, BE IT KNOWN:

WHEREAS, beginning in December 2019, a novel coronavirus, now designated as COVID-19, was detected in mainland China, and has since spread throughout the world; and

WHEREAS, the World Health Organization declared COVID-19 a worldwide pandemic on March 11, 2020; and

WHEREAS, President Donald Trump has proclaimed the COVID-19 outbreak a national emergency in the United States; and Governor Greg Abbott has declared a state of disaster for all counties in Texas; and

WHEREAS, costs incurred to prepare for and respond to COVID-19 are beginning to mount at the county level; and

WHEREAS, Trinity County has already taken significant measures to prepare for and prevent the spread of COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, some schools, universities and other governmental entities are beginning to alter their schedules, and some venues are beginning to temporarily close, as precautionary responses to the increasing presence of COVID-19 in Texas; and

WHEREAS, extraordinary measure must be taken to contain COVID-19 and prevent its spread throughout Trinity County, Texas;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE JUDGE OF THE COUNTY OF TRINITY;

- 1. That a local state of disaster is hereby declared for Trinity County pursuant to section 418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code.
- 2. Pursuant to 418.018(b) of the Texas Government Code, the state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days from the date of this declaration unless continued or renewed by the Commissioners Court of Trinity County.
 - A. To be extended // days by approval of the Trinity County Commissioners

 Court
- 3. Pursuant to 418.018(c) of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the County Clerk.
- 4. Pursuant to 418.018(d) of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster activate the Trinity County emergency management plan.
- 5. That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.
