

# TRINITY COUNTY DECLARATION OF DISASTER

**WHEREAS**, the County of Trinity on the **26<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2020** is in imminent threat of widespread or severe damage, injury, or loss of life or property resulting from Hurricane Laura; and


**WHEREAS**, the County Judge of Trinity County has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE COUNTY JUDGE OF TRINITY COUNTY;**

1. That a local state of disaster is hereby declared for the Trinity County pursuant to 418.018(a) of the Texas Government Code.
2. Pursuant to 418.018(b) of the Texas Government Code, the state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days from the date of this declaration unless continued or renewed by the Commissioner's Court of Trinity County.
3. Pursuant to 418.018(c) of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the County Clerk.
4. Pursuant to 418.018(d) of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster activates the County emergency management plan.
5. That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.
