Please read this order carefully. It contains rules which will govern appearances at the scheduled proceedings. Failure to comply with this order will result in a warrant being issued for the Defendant's arrest.

- 1. ALL DEFENDANTS AND THEIR ATTORNEYS ARE <u>REQUIRED</u> TO APPEAR <u>IN PERSON</u> AT THE SCHEDULED PRE-TRIAL HEARING UNLESS:
 - A. The Defendant has filed a statement with the County Clerk with copies provided to the Court Administrator and the County Attorney stipulating that the Defendant is ready for trial <u>and</u> that the Defendant has no pending pre-trial motions to be heard; <u>or</u>,
 - B. Prior to the time scheduled for the Pre-Trial Hearing, a plea bargain offer has been accepted <u>and</u> a date scheduled for disposition.
- 2. ALL PRE-TRIAL MOTIONS, INCLUDING MOTIONS FOR CONTINUANCE, MUST BE FILED WITH THE COUNTY CLERK AND COPIES RECEIVED BY THE COUNTY ATTORNEY NO LATER THAN February 2, 2022, OR BE FOREVER BARRED.
- No informal motions for continuance will be considered.

- 4. It will be each Defendant's responsibility to contact the Court Administrator, to determine the Defendant's position on the docket. Because a case is currently at the bottom of the docket will be no excuse for a Defendant not being ready for trial should that case be reached.
- The cases on this docket will be called in the order listed. Cases not reached on the scheduled jury trial date will be set on the next available jury docket.
- 6. Any Defendant who has entered into a plea bargain with the State shall file a statement to that effect with the County Clerk <u>BEFORE THE PLEA BARGAIN ACCEPTANCE</u> <u>DEADLINE</u>. Faxed statements are acceptable. Copies of the statement must be provided to the County Attorney and the Court Administrator. On or before the first business day after the statement is filed, the Defendant shall contact the Court Administrator to schedule a court date for disposition of the plea.
- 7. AFTER THE PLEA BARGAIN DEADLINE AND BEFORE THE SCHEDULED JURY TRIALS HAVE BEEN COMPLETED, THE ONLY PLEA AGREEMENTS THAT WILL BE ACCEPTED BY THE COURT ARE OPEN PLEAS OF GUILTY TO THE COURT WITH THE COURT TO ASSESS PUNISHMENT.
- No one other than the County Judge or the Court Administrator has the authority to authorize a continuance pertaining to any scheduled deadline, hearing or trial.
